In recent days, the Constitutional Court of the Central African Republic has been the target of attacks and threats against its judges and its president, as well as attempts to undermine its independence. It was also the subject of the Government's desire to retire the President, due to the latest decisions taken by the Court, and which would be akin to a disciplinary measure while the judges are irremovable.


Considering this situation, the Conference of Constitutional Jurisdictions of Africa, of which the Constitutional Court of the Central African Republic is a founding member, takes the place of marking unwavering support for the constitutional judges and their head, Pr. Danièle DARLAN, and expresses its solidarity with them and recalls that the irremovability of judges is a fundamental principle relating to the independence of the judiciary.
